WHAT IS AN EDUCATIONAL SUCCESS COACH?

An educational success coach works with students from pre-school through graduate school to teach invaluable executive functioning skills that are crucial to success both in and out of the classroom. Skills include organization, time management, study skills, future planning, and how to break down big projects (like a dissertation or a science project) into manageable chunks. Educational coaches typically select a specific area of expertise, like college planning, academic support, academic/extracurricular management, or special needs.
